We are excited for the start of the Spring Semester as we are planning to welcome back students to campus in a Hybrid setting. The following information will help you prepare and understand your student's schedule.

Hybrid Schedule for Easton High and Easton Community Day

Students attending school in the hybrid model will be on campus two days a week (either Tues/Wed or Thurs/Fri) from 8:10am-12:30pm. All students will work from home on Mondays.

Off Campus Days-Distance Learning

The expectation for students on days where they are off campus is that they work on their online classes from home for at least three hours. Additional engagement may be needed depending on their progress of being on pace or behind.

Curriculum

Our Easton High and Community Day School students will continue to be assigned online classes through Edgenuity. This allows for students to do the same work on their individual courses while at home that they would be doing on campus.

Devices

Students should continue to use personal devices and/or district issued technology while at home. When students are on campus, they will use individual Chromeboxes that are assigned to them only. Students do not need to bring devices to school on days they are scheduled to be on campus.

Healthy and Safety Procedures

All students will be screened upon entry to campus each day they attend. Screenings include questions regarding potential illnesses, contact with individuals that may be ill, and temperature checks. Staff will also continue to be screened each day. Disinfecting materials are readily available in all rooms/offices. Students will be socially distanced at work stations and masks will be required. Potential illnesses and symptoms

Regardless of the possibility of symptoms being related to COVID-19, we request that any student experiencing **any** illness not attend on days they are scheduled for campus.
